

2023 Summer Health & Safety Protocols
In a Nutshell

1. **We are excited to have you and your campers join us!**
2. **We encourage** all to be up to date on their vaccinations for the safety of others. Please provide those updated records on your health form.
3. **Masking in our food service line:** Please be prepared to bring at least two masks per camper in a zip-lock bag with camper's name on the bag.
 - a. Dining Room Food Service Line – **Mandatory that everyone wear a mask in the food service line at each meal.** The serving line is our highest risk area for the spread of any germs.
 - b. Masking is optional at all other times and in all other camp spaces.
4. **Covid**
 - a. **Symptoms or Positive Test results** - We ask all guests to report positive test results. If you have symptoms, please mask and report your symptoms to the camp staff in order to keep all our guests safe. If you test positive while at camp, we will ask you to return home immediately.
 - b. If you must cancel due to positive exposure to Covid-19 please notify the LO registrar to request a refund.

These guidelines are consistent with current CDC guidance for “gathering and activities” as of April 2023.

In Christian care and love for one another we ask that you do what you can to keep yourself, your family, and all people gathered in community at our camps safe and healthy. Please report any health concerns and remain home if you are diagnosed with any contagious illness.
